The Flute Concertos are especially innovative both as documents of performance technique and examples of the composer's most imaginative writing. Three of the Concertos have descriptive titles which, although not strictly programmatic, clearly evoke the mood and characteristics of a sea-storm (La tempesta di mare), night (La notte) and the goldfinch (Il cardellino).
