Tcherepnin's extensive travels, after he had fled revolutionary Russia, can be traced through the evocations of sorrow in *Feuilles libres* to a synthesis of his earlier styles in the strongly narrative *Eight Pieces*. The aptly named *Préludes nostalgiques* contrast with the delightfully perverse *Tanz*, while Expressions is comparable to a miniature Mussorgskian *Pictures* at an *Exhibition*.
