

# A Decade of the Classics

It was Milton's great poem, **Paradise Lost**, read by the English classical actor **Anton Lesser** that set **Naxos AudioBooks** on its particular journey to record the great classics of Western literature.

That was 10 years ago, and since then we have recorded more than 250 titles ranging from Classic Fiction for adults and juniors; poetry, biographies and histories which have both scholarly and literary presence; and classic drama, dominated, of course, by **Shakespeare** presented by some of the leading British actors. In addition, we have recorded selections from **The Bible** and great epics, such as **Dante's The Divine Comedy**.

And we feel that our own original texts – introductions to classical music, English literature and the theatre and biographies of famous people for younger listeners – have made a special contribution to audiobook literature.

These have all been recorded to the highest standards, and enhanced by the use of classical music taken from the Naxos and Marco Polo catalogues. We felt from the beginning that, generally, it was not sufficient to have just a voice reading the text, and that, as in film, music can be used imaginatively to set the period and the atmosphere of a story. It is this, in addition to our careful choice of readers, that makes a Naxos audiobook a distinctive experience.

And it has led to numerous awards for reading, production and presentation.

It has been an extraordinary and enriching 10 years. Working on texts from Ancient Greece to **Samuel Beckett** gives a very special view of civilisation and man's contribution to society. If history is a record of events, poetry, drama and fiction is a record of man's insights and feelings. And what has been made clear time and again is that listening to **Homer or Plato**, and **Austen** and **James Joyce** is a very direct experience. Classics are not dusty or unapproachable; and, almost always, far more accessible than their reputation suggests. **Chaucer** is a delight. The dilemmas of **Dostoyevsky** are just as relevant to us today; **Dracula** still provokes a chill and even without recourse to DNA analysis, **Sherlock Holmes** solves crimes.

The medium of the spoken word gives us the chance to meet for the first time, or to reconnect with the classics despite the fast pace of our modern lives.


Naxos AudioBooks was the first audiobook label to offer everything on CD as well as tape. So we hope that neither the medium nor the message will date.

The epics too are well served with music. Curiously, grand 19th-century works – such as Schumann's Julius Caesar Overture – are perfect companions for the majestic words of Gibbon in The Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire, while 17th-century anthems echo the literary character of the Authorized Version of the Bible.

The music of our own century also plays its role. Music by Buck and Siegel is curiously appropriate for the timeless world of Oedipus.

All this wonderful music has enabled **Naxos AudioBooks** to produce some unique titles. The History of Classical Music, The History of Opera, the musical biographies and, in 2004, The Story of Classical Music for younger listeners would have been impossible without the recorded riches of the **Naxos** catalogue.
