- 1** Chorus:
*Let God arise, and let his enemies be scattered:
let them also that hate him fly before him.*
- 2** Duet – Bass and Alto:
*Like as the smoke vanisheth,
so shalt thou drive them away:
like as wax melteth at the fire,
so let the ungodly perish at the presence of God.*
- 3** Duet – Bass and Alto:
O sing unto God, and sing praises unto his name.
- 4** Chorus:
*Blessed be God.
Alleluja.*

I will magnify thee, HWV 250b

- 5** Solo – Alto:
*I will magnify thee, O God my King:
and I will praise thy name for ever and ever.*
- 6** Duet – Bass and Alto:
O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness.
- 7** Chorus and quartet:
*Glory and worship are before him:
power and honour are in his sanctuary.*
- 8** Duet – Bass and Alto and chorus:
*Tell it out among the heathen that the Lord is King:
and that he made the world so fast it cannot be moved.*
- 9** Solo – Alto:
*Righteousness and equity are the habitation of thy seat:
mercy and truth shall go before thy face.*
- 10** Duet – Bass and Alto and chorus:
*My mouth shall speak the praise of the Lord:
and let all flesh give thanks unto his holy name.
Amen.*

Sextet and chorus:

*As pants the hart for cooling streams,
so longs my soul for thee, O God.*

Solo – Alto and quartet:

*Tears are my daily food: while thus they say,
where is now thy God?*

Recit – Bass:

*Now when I think thereupon, I pour out my heart by myself:
for I went with the multitude, and brought them out into the house of God.*

Chorus:

*In the voice of praise and thanksgiving:
among such as keep holy day.*

14

Duet – Alto I and Alto II:

*Why so full of grief, O my soul:
why so disquieted within me?*

15

Chorus:

Put thy trust in God: for I will praise him.

O Sing unto the Lord, HWV 249a

Solo – Alto and chorus:

O sing unto the Lord a new song, all the whole earth.

17

Solo – Alto:

*Sing unto the Lord, and praise his name:
declare his honour unto the heathen,
and his wonders unto the people.*

18

Accompagnetto – Bass:

*The Lord is great, and cannot worthily be praised:
he is more to be feared than all gods.*

19

Solo – Bass:

*Glory and worship are before him:
power and honour are in his sanctuary.*

20

Duet – Bass and Alto and chorus:

*O worship the lord in the beauty of holiness:
let the whole earth stand in awe of him.*

- 21 Solo – Alto and chorus:
*Let the heavens rejoice and let the earth be glad:
let the sea make a noise and all that therein is.*

- 22 Solo – Alto:
*Tears are my daily food:
while thus they say, where is now thy God?
Now when I think thereupon,
I pour out my heart by myself:
for I went with the multitude,

- 23 Duet – Treble and Alto:
*Why so full of grief, O my soul:
why so disquieted within me?*
