### The Places



### The Music


The music of Elgar was rooted in his own part of England.

His *Enigma Variations* offers portraits of his friends and neighbours, the enigma lying in the unrevealed melody that he claimed would be generally known and that would go with the whole set of variations. The puzzle remains unsolved. Other music used includes Elgar's *Serenade for Strings*, *Pomp and Circumstance March, No. 1* and *Salut d'amour*.






