Schierbeck's opera maintains an exquisite musical balance between the lyrical and the comic, and this recording brings new life to Schierbeck's tuneful music with a strong Nordic singers' cast in front of the **DANISH NATIONAL SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA** conducted by **MICHAEL SCHØNWANDT**.
