

Andris Nelsons and the Wiener Philharmoniker confront the uncompromising power of Gustav Mahler's *Symphony No. 6*, the composer's darkest and most enigmatic symphonic statement. With gripping intensity and architectural control, Nelsons traces the work's inexorable march from martial determination to catastrophic collapse. The famous hammer blows in the finale strike with devastating force, while moments of lyrical repose are shaped with haunting restraint. This performance reveals Mahler's *Sixth* as a tragic drama of fate and resistance, uncompromising in its emotional impact. Recorded at the Salzburg Festival 2020, the concert forms part of the Wiener Philharmoniker's Mahler cycle with Andris Nelsons.
