Now largely forgotten, the Ukranian-born American pianist Mischa Levitzki won a considerable reputation for himself, at first in Europe and then, principally in the interwar years, in the United States. His death in 1941 at the age of 42 was overshadowed by world events, but he had by then secured a position for himself as one of the leading virtuosi of the day.
