It features not only some of the finest Italian singers of the day but the combined Italian Radio orchestras and choirs from Rome and Turin, under the inspired baton of Victor De Sabata. An immediate hit both in Italy and abroad, this recording of the *Requiem* documents both a unique occasion in the history of Italian Radio and a very Italian, intensely sensual and tragic interpretation.
