



Widely respected as the principal symphonic composer of his native Latvia, Janis Ivanovs is represented here by a sombre Fifth Symphony written in the aftermath of World War II and an optimistic Twelfth Symphony. His musical language, influenced by Russian contemporaries, makes us of distinctively national folk-song elements.
