

Russian composer Anton Rubinstein wrote a considerable amount of music in both operatic and symphonic forms, although little has remained in the repertoire. It is the salon pieces for piano by which he is remembered, including his 24 portraits, *Kamenniy-ostrov*, which mix virtuosity with attractive melodies.
