Sylvio Lazzari, a neglected French composer of Austrian origins who had gained a sporadic renown as an opera composer, produced a powerful *Symphony* and a dramatic *Symphonic Suite* following the cyclic form of the school of César Franck through a language already sympathizing with more modern tendencies of French music of the 20th century.
