

The German born composer Friedrich Kuhlau (1786-1832) is one of the main figures in early Danish romanticism. Kuhlau's particular importance lies in the international impulses he brought to Danish music. His cosmopolitan though by no means impersonal style reflects the influence of Mozart and Beethoven.
