

Svend Nielsen (b. 1937) is a thoroughly lyrical composer. In recent years dramatic undercurrents of expression have surfaced in his music. However, Nielsen's compositions remain essentially impressionistic, characterized as they are by lucid scoring and a refined sense of structure.
