

Ole Schmidt (b. 1928) is best known as a conductor, but has written a large number of works since his debut in 1955. His musical roots are not only in Neoclassicists like Hindemith and Stravinsky, but also in the playful freedom of jazz. Ole Schmidt composed the music for Carl Theodor Dreyer's world-famous silent film *The Passion of Joan of Arc* (1927) at the request of the Hollywood producer Annett Wolf. The music, which in its original version lasts 82 minutes, just like the film, was premiered in Los Angeles in 1983.
