Mihály Mosonyi

Known mainly for his operas and symphonic music, Mihály Mosonyi composed until 1859 under his original name, Michael Brand. After this time Mosonyi's music took on a more deliberately Hungarian character. His admirers included Franz Liszt.

Piano Trios

Mosonyi's *Piano Trios* date from early in his career when he was heavily influenced by the works of Beethoven and Hummel. Nevertheless, the *Grand Nocturne for Piano, Violin and Cello* is an ambitious work, with constantly varying moods and demanding much of its performers.
