

HERMAN D. KOPPEL (1908-1998) was one of the greatest Danish musical personalities of the twentieth century. Hard-working as a composer, pianist and teacher, he was the patriarch of a musical dynasty that has become a Danish counterpart of the Bach family in Germany. In Denmark the name of Koppel has become synonymous with musicianship of the highest standards ranging over three generations and innumerable genres.
