

CARL NIELSEN'S *Woodwind Quintet* from 1922 is a major work in the international chamber music literature. On this new release the Quintet is featured together with other chamber music works by the composer involving one or more wind players. The music selection ranges in time from Nielsen's early youth to his mature mastery, and the selection also includes three small pieces from the music for *The Mother*, including the classic *The Fog Is Lifting*.
