

NIELS W. GADE ∞ PIANO WORKS

MARIANNA SHIRINYAN, *piano*

His instrument may have been the violin, but **Niels W. Gade** (1817–90) was a great admirer of piano virtuosos Felix Mendelssohn and Robert Schumann. In fact, the great Danish Romantic composer left behind a collection of piano works that inspired both professionals and amateurs. Breathing new life into a selection of these, Armenian-Danish pianist **Marianna Shirinyan** performs Gade's poetic *Aquarelles*, the almost orchestral *Sonata in E minor*, four chopin-esque *Fantasy Pieces* and the little *Chanson danoise*, here in its first recording.
