A magnificent series of seven symphonies, tautly-argued, deeply atmospheric and overwhelmingly powerful, has assured Sibelius a place among the very greatest of 20th century composers. More than any other composer, Sibelius expressed the emergent sense of nationhood in Finland at the end of the 19th century, particularly in Kullervo, based on the Finnish national epic *The Kalevala*.
