Yoshiko Iwai

A pupil of Hitoshi Kobayashi at the Tokyo National University of Fine Arts and Music, Yoshiko Iwai won the Ataka Prize and was second prize-winner in the 52nd Japanese National Music Competition, before continuing her training at the Detmold Musikhochschule with Prof. Friedrich Wilhelm Schnurr. She has won a number of important prizes and awards, including second prize at the 1989 Darmstadt 3rd European Chopin Competition and second prize in the 1994 Zürich International Géza Anda Competition. She has given frequent concerts in Japan, Germany and elsewhere in Europe and has recorded extensively for radio.
