Born in France in 1886, Marcel Dupré became the most famous organist-composer of the twentieth century, his substantial catalogue of works devoted to the instrument. As a performer he became renowned for his brilliant improvisations, and from one of these was derived the *Symphonie-Passion*, providing a glorious array of tonal colours and dynamic contrasts. It is one of the most important and imposing works composed for large organ.

Recorded in the Katholische Heilig-Geist-Kirche, Mannheim in May 1997.
