The most substantial work of this selection of Franz Schubert's music for piano duet is the *Fantasie in F minor*, D. 940, which the composer completed in the last year of his life. The *Fantasie* exhibits a masterful balance between passages of poignant melody and passionate drama. The *Overture in F major*, D. 675, shares some of this mood of drama, whilst the *Variations on an Original Theme*, D. 968a, are lighter in mood. The recital is rounded out with a selection of occasional pieces.
