Nicholas Jackson, who was organist at St David's Cathedral, has achieved increasing distinction by the diversity of his activities as an organist, harpsichordist and composer. His *Mass for a Saint's Day* has become established in the repertoire of cathedrals and churches worldwide, and his subsequent compositions include an opera, cathedral music, some substantial organ works and a quantity of music for trumpet and organ. The music on this recording is written in a modern-romantic idiom, admitting to the French influences of Messiaen, Duruflé and Langlais.
