Born in France around 1656, Jacques Paisible lived and worked in London for more than 40 years. Like many of his contemporaries, he became very active as a supplier of instrumental music for London theatre productions. This collection of Setts was most likely intended for both public performance and interval entertainment and fully captures the cosmopolitan mix of Italian and French styles so popular in England at the time.
