

Schumann was one of the greatest composers for the piano, enriching its literature with a series of poetic works in which classical structure and romantic expression are masterfully combined. Always extremely interested in education, Schumann wrote a number of works such as the *Album for the Young*, featured on this new recording, which were specifically designed to aid the younger pianist whilst still possessing the freshness, vitality and lyricism that characterise all of Schumann's finest music.
