

Schubert's works conceived for domestic music making cover a wide emotional range. The *Fantasy in F minor* is a late work of great stature, demanding of its players a more than usual sensitivity and pianistic capability. The two sets of *Variations, in B flat and B minor*, are both compact, but contain much variety of mood and atmosphere. The *Rondo in A major* and *Allegro 'Lebensstürme'* are also significant works, rewarding both to play and to hear.
