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Mozart's *Serenades* and *Divertimenti* were occasional pieces often played outdoors before large, popular audiences. The four works on this recording include two of his Salzburg wind *Divertimenti*, though neither of these prepares the listener for the intensity, power and grave beauty of the magnificent *C minor Serenade* composed in Vienna in 1782. Mozart himself thought so highly of this work that he later arranged it for string quintet.
