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This collection presents major twentieth-century works for saxophone and orchestra by Henri Tomasi and Frank Martin alongside well-known works by Ravel and Piazzolla, arranged for saxophone and orchestra. The disc concludes with world première recordings of music by the Greek composer Dimitris Dragatakis and the Spanish composer Pedro Iturralde. Described as “one of the best saxophone soloists of his generation”, Theodore Kerkezos has previously appeared on Naxos with a disc of virtuoso showpieces by Debussy, Milhaud, Ibert, Villa-Lobos, Glazunov and Karamessini (8.557063).
