

The symphonies of Johann Baptist Vañhal are among the most important works of the classical period. Bold and imaginative, powerful and lyrical, Vañhal's symphonies are only now beginning to win wider recognition as the masterpieces they are. This recording features one of the composer's most extraordinary early works, the turbulent *Symphony in C minor* (Bryan c2) and the masterly *Symphony in A flat* with its hauntingly beautiful slow movement with solo horn.
