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Most of the pieces on this disc were written for Simard and Grauwels by living composers. Heard here in a version for flute and percussion, *The History of the Tango* was dedicated to Marc Grauwels by Astor Piazzolla in 1985. Frédéric Devreese's delightful little miniature *Butterfly* was originally the music for a television series called *Romance*. Arvo Pärt's *Spiegel im Spiegel* (Mirror in the Mirror), scored in this new version for alto flute and marimba, is an expansive yet serene lullaby. In Ravi Shankar's *The Enchanted Morning*, East meets West. Based on the *raga todī*, the piece begins slowly and steadily builds up to a conclusion of thrilling virtuosity for both players.
