AMERICAN CLASSICS

Of Armenian and Scottish extraction, the American composer Alan Hovhaness was a trend-setting pioneer who absorbed a variety of archaic and modern influences from East and West. He once said: "My purpose is to create music, not for snobs, but for all people – music which is beautiful and healing." Described by the composer's wife as his 'true masterpiece', *Khrimian Hairig*, with its trumpet solo, recalls the heroic Armenian priest of the title. Hovhaness' virtuoso and romantic *Guitar Concerto* was written for the Bolivian guitarist Juan Calderon. The *Symphony No. 60 'To the Appalachian Mountains'*, expresses the composer's love of the music and folk poetry of the Appalachians. Other works by Alan Hovhaness can be heard on Naxos 8.559207 and 8.559241.
