Joan Tower's bold and energetic music, with its striking imagery and novel structural forms, has won her large, enthusiastic audiences. *Made in America* is a fantasy on the theme of the unofficial national anthem, *America the Beautiful*, and its orchestration depicts the color and landscape of the country. The work has already been performed in all fifty states, an unprecedented achievement for a brand-new composition. The rhythmically driven *Tambor* demonstrates Tower's self-proclaimed passion for percussion, and her *Concerto for Orchestra* features solo passages from individual instruments, requiring precision and virtuosity from soloists and ensemble alike.
