# Leroy ANDERSON

(1908-1975)



## AMERICAN CLASSICS

Praised by composer John Williams as 'one of the great American masters of light orchestral music', Leroy Anderson was a meticulous craftsman, a composer and arranger of many popular tunes that, once heard, are never forgotten. Volume 5 in Naxos' complete edition of his orchestral works presents highlights from his charming 1958 musical *Goldilocks*, which ran for 161 performances on Broadway and won two *Tony* awards. His *Suite of Carols for Woodwind Ensemble*, written three years earlier, includes both well known and less familiar Christmas tunes, each given the magical Anderson touch.
