George Rochberg's relationship with the past is not one of nostalgia; it is one of intimate, living familiarity. *Partita-Variations*, an energetic and exuberant work, makes unpredictable forays into realms of tragedy, innocence, mischief and heartfelt affection. *Nach Bach*, written for the harpsichordist Igor Kipnis, is a discourse between two composers active centuries apart, yet united in spirit and dramatic intent.
