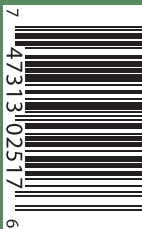

This fourth volume of Leo Brouwer's guitar music consists of works ranging from his earliest, the neo-classical *Suite No. 1 'Antigua'*, written at the age of sixteen, to his most recent compositions. Written in 2004, *La ciudad de las columnas* (The City of Columns), a nickname for Havana, is an evocative musical journey of various landmarks and images of the Cuban capital. The disc closes with *Yemaya*, inspired by a goddess from the Afro-Cuban Santería/Yoruba religion, written by Leo Brouwer's close friend and protégé, Joaquín Clerch.
