This final volume in the Naxos edition of Granados' complete piano music begins with the composer's final work, an impassioned and colourful transcription of the *Intermezzo* from the opera *Goyescas*. The intricate *Marchas militares* for piano duet are among the composer's most delightful compositions, while the brilliant transcription of Albéniz's *Triana* from *Iberia* is his only work scored for two pianos.
