A virtuoso pianist and renowned conductor in his day, Wilhelm Stenhammar achieved early success with his magnificently wide-ranging and Brahmsian *Piano Concerto No. 1*. After many years of mixed fortunes as a composer he found his personal voice in the remarkable *Piano Concerto No. 2*. Conceived as a single span, this vividly affirmative romantic masterpiece was the wellspring for his *Serenade* (8.572186) and *Symphony No. 2* (8.553888). Award-winning soloist Niklas Sivelöv has also recorded Stenhammar's solo piano works (8.553730).
