The popular overture from Vaughan Williams's incidental music for Aristophanes's *The Wasps* introduces a suite whose mischievously witty, noble and farcical movements underline the play's satire of the Athenian legal system. A similar vivacity characterises his *English Folk Song Suite* and *The Running Set*, where Vaughan Williams relishes setting tunes such as *Barrack Hill*, *Irish Reel*, *The Blackthorn Stick* and *Cock o' the North*. Folksong-like melodies also feature in his magnificent *Piano Concerto*, in which the magisterial influence of Bach and Busoni may also be heard.
