The sheer variety of Leonard Bernstein's music can be savored in this wide-ranging disc, consisting largely of transcriptions. Bernstein's immersion in theatrical music is reflected in Clare Grundman's unique transcription of the *Candide* suite whilst his film score for *On the Waterfront* is presented in its symphonic suite form in Jay Bocook's transcription. The nostalgia of the orchestral *Divertimento*, written for the centenary of the Boston Symphony Orchestra, is richly brought out in this adaptation. All performances are by the award-winning University of South Carolina Wind Ensemble.
