Qu Wei

Born in Changzhou in 1917, Qu Wei established himself early in his career as a composer for the cinema. From 1955 to 1959 he studied composition at the Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory, returning to China to take up an appointment as composer for the Shanghai Symphony Orchestra. He collaborated in the composition of the well-known Chinese opera *The White-Haired Girl*, which was transformed into a ballet in the 1960s and later became the source of a symphonic suite by Qu Wei. His *Monument to the People's Heroes* enjoys similar popularity.
