2024 marked the 200th anniversary of the birth of Austrian composer Anton Bruckner. For Herbert Blomstedt, Bruckner was a genius and the greatest symphonist since Beethoven. Probably the world's longest-serving conductor, with an eventful career spanning seven decades, Blomstedt celebrated his 97th birthday on 11 July 2024 with the Bamberg Symphony, performing Anton Bruckner's unfinished Ninth Symphony in the Basilica of St. Florian Monastery, a place with which the composer was closely associated throughout his life and where he is buried.
