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György Sándor was born in Budapest and studied there at the Liszt Academy under Bela Bartok (piano) and Zoltan Kodaly (composition). His association with Bartok continued closely up to the composer's death in 1945 and this resulted in him performing the World Premiere of the master's Third Piano Concerto in 1946.

"Mr. Gyorgy Sándor is one of the best pianists of our younger generation. His performing is clear, energetic and emotional, without being sentimental. The variety of his program (repertoire) is worth mentioning. Next to classical and romantic repertoire, he is not neglecting contemporary music. Therefore he may be considered a great performer of new (today's) piano music."
