During the moving final scene of his film 'Modern Times' (1936), Charlie Chaplin shows a picture of a man and a woman. She is crying. He moves his finger to the corner of his mouth, draws a smile, and conjures up a smile on her face. During this final image, a melody called 'Smile' is being played, written by Chaplin himself. 'Smile' is also the culmination of the works collected on this CD. They make up a unity around a song cycle by the Belgian composer Godfried Devreese (1893-1962), written during the horrors of the First World War.
