"After withdrawing to his house at Passy near Paris, Rossini used to entertain himself by composing instrumental pieces (...) under the title of Pêches de viellesse (Sins of old age). (...) By comparison with the collection Quelques riens pour album recorded for Dynamic by the same pianist (...) the Album de Château (...) is on a different plane: we (...) have (...) the clear intention to develop a musical discourse within wider parameters. (...) In short, Rossini is one of those few musicians who know how to make fun of music and, naturally, of its listeners".
