The Italian composer **Nino Rota** is best known today for his film scores. He worked for the directors Fellini, Visconti, and notably Ford Coppola for whom he wrote the music for the first two films in the *Godfather* trilogy. It is easy then to forget his sizable contribution to the concert hall and theatre. The three works on this disc show Rota composing on a large scale, yet the music remains as tuneful and entertaining as that of his film music.
