Recorded inside the Desert View Watchtower on the South Rim of Grand Canyon in Arizona, this collection of American Indian songs celebrates the most ancient sounds to emerge from Öngtupqa – the traditional Hopi name for Grand Canyon. Clark Tenakhongva's vocals are accompanied by Gary Stroutsos playing a replica of a Hopi long flute, and Matthew Nelson on clay pot percussion.
