



Georges Bizet died at the tragically young age of 36 while *Carmen* was still in its first run, and he never witnessed the huge international acclaim his opera received. Filled with jealousy and passion, the gripping and ultimately tragic narrative of *Carmen* initially shocked audiences, but with an abundance of memorable tunes, it remains unchallenged as one of the most popular operas ever written. *Carmen* received its premiere at the Opéra Comique in Paris in 1875, and this internationally acclaimed production, performed on period instruments, represents a triumphant return to its home theatre.
