

The young American soprano Angel Blue – hailed by Plácido Domingo as ‘the next Leontyne Price’ – displays exceptional artistic versatility on this, her first solo album. George Gershwin’s classic ‘Summertime’, which ‘soars sweetly to angelic heights’ (*Financial Times*), sets the scene for a wide-ranging recital in which her luminous and pure tone comes to the fore, from Liszt, Rachmaninov and Strauss to rousing spirituals, songs by acclaimed American contemporaries Heggie and Adolphe, and intoxicating Spanish zarzuelas.
