



The early death of the Finnish composer Ernst Mielck, in October 1899, two days before his 22nd birthday, robbed music of an extraordinarily gifted musician – he was also a fine pianist – and perhaps one of the major voices of the next generation: the rapid evolution in his language in the three years covered by this CD is remarkable. The two overtures and cantatas make clear that he was already a gifted composer in the post-Schumann Romantic tradition, and the *Finnish Suite* written in the last year of his life shows a striking simplification of his textures and what seems to have been a nascent nationalism.
